The yacht's interior layout comfortably accommodates up to six guests in three cabins, including a spacious master suite and two guest cabins. Each cabin is furnished with updated décor, creating a warm and inviting atmosphere that ensures a relaxing stay on board.

Powered by twin MTU 2000 M91 engines, **MR. M** boasts impressive performance, cruising at 30 knots and reaching a maximum speed of 40 knots. Its efficient fuel consumption across various speeds, coupled with a shallow draft of 1.4 meters, makes this yacht ideal for navigating secluded bays and anchoring close to shorelines.

For adventure enthusiasts, **MR. M** comes equipped with an array of water sports gear, including electric surfboard, electric paddleboard (Kymera board), 3 seadoo sea scooters, 3 person sea kayak, 2 paddle boards and snorkeling equipment. Guests can indulge in thrilling water activities while the attentive crew ensures safety and enjoyment throughout the journey.


