OWO is a 35-metre **Azimut** motor yacht (2021) designed for comfortable and versatile onboard living. Her semi-displacement GRP hull provides stability and fuel efficiency, while twin MTU 16V 2000 M93 engines paired with two Kohler generators ensure reliable operation of all onboard systems.

Accommodation is arranged for 10 guests, featuring a full-beam master suite on the main deck and four guest cabins on the lower deck - two doubles and two twins - making the layout ideal for both families and groups of friends. A crew of seven handles service, safety, and guest activities.

OWO's exterior spaces are designed to support a wide range of leisure experiences. The flybridge features sun loungers, a hardtop, dining area, and BBQ, while the bow lounge includes a jacuzzi and a platform that can be transformed into an open-air cinema. The aft deck offers an additional relaxation area with easy access to the sea.

Her extensive water toy collection includes an Axopar 37 XC Cross Cabin chase tender, two Sea-Doo GTX Limited 300 jet skis, four Seabob F5 SR, a wakeboard, water skis, SUP boards, inflatables, snorkeling gear, and fishing equipment. Certified crew members ensure safe use of all equipment and assist guests during activities.

OWO is a modern charter-focused yacht offering a well-organized layout, professional crew, and a diverse onboard entertainment program. She is well suited for active week-long itineraries, peaceful anchorage stays, and experiences that blend comfort with adventure.

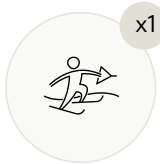

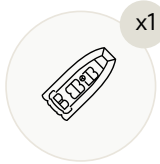
